Subject: New Era for Snowy Hydro SouthCare

This morning in Canberra, His Excellency, the Governor General of Australia. Major General Michael Jeffrey, officially launched the new look Snowy Hydro SouthCare Rescue Helicopter Service.

The new helicopter colour scheme incorporates the corporate brand and colours of the major sponsor, Snowy Hydro Limited, who recently committed to a further five years of support valued at \$2.15 million.

The new look Snowy Hydro SouthCare Rescue Helicopter was introduced to the public in spectacular fashion, flying in over Canberra this morning before descending over Parliament House, with the Governor General and official party onboard to be met by more than 150 guests, waiting media and members of the public.
