
SNOWY HYDRO RESPONSE MATRIX TO FIRE DANGER RATINGS





In the event of a bushfire, RFS (NSW)/CFA (Vic)/CFS (SA) bushfire alert levels (i.e. Advice, Watch and Act and Emergency Warning) and the SHL response to the same will be communicated to SHL-all via a Sitrep.

Total Fire Bans (TOBAN) may be enacted by National Parks or Rural/Country Fire Authorities. During a TOBAN, all outdoor hot works will be suspended.
