2024 Community Grants Overview

Snowy Hydro is dedicated to supporting the local communities where we operate. Through our Community Grants Program we offer grant funding up to \$10k to support a variety of community initiatives and innovative projects within the Snowy Mountains. The grant funding is distributed to applicants that demonstrate initiatives that will have an impact on, and fit within, our community commitment pillars of education and development, health and wellbeing, regional capacity building and environment.

In the first round of funding in 2024 Snowy Hydro Community Grant Program, a total of 89 grant applications were received. Of these, 34% met the selection criteria and were approved for funding.

Snowy Hydro is proud to announce that a total of \$204k will be distributed to a diverse range of community groups and events, supporting initiatives underpinned by our community commitment pillars. This funding fosters economic, social and regional resilience within the Snowy Mountains.
